ACTS 17: 10-12

In Berea

¹⁰ As soon as it was night, the believers sent Paul and Silas away to Berea. On arriving there, they went to the Jewish synagogue. ¹¹ Now the Berean Jews were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true. ¹² As a result, many of them believed, as did also a number of prominent Greek women and many Greek men.



Questions for Discussion

1. Share your observations about something that seems to be better than when you were younger and something that seems to be worse.
2. Why are people drawn toward the heresy of Restorationism?
3. When the Bereans were introduced to new teachings, they compared them to the Scriptures daily. What do you think keeps people from daily Bible reading?
4. What is one thing you can do this week to be better about reading your Bible?
5. What "next step" will you take this week toward getting into the rhythm of daily Bible readings? Who is someone who could keep you accountable toward taking that step?

As you close your time together, have each person share a word that represents a step that God is asking them to take this week and lift those words up to God during a time of prayer.
