Questions for Discussion

1. What are you thankful for in your life today?
2. Read the passage together. In the ancient Jewish tradition, the priest would read the first line, and the congregation would respond with the line, “His Love Endures Forever.”
3. The Hebrew word for “love” in this passage is *hesed*. It means that God has not destroyed or wiped us off the face of the earth due to our sin. [Lamentations 3:22-23] What do you think about that? Why is our sin considered so serious?
4. How might the idea of being lavished with infinite love for eternity affect your outlook on life here today?
5. How has God revealed Himself to you? (We talked about general revelation and special revelation at church on Sunday.)
6. In what way(s) can you practice repetition in your faith journey over the next few weeks as we look towards Christmas?
