Questions for Discussion

1. Who is your longest friendship with? Tell your group how you met and one of your favorite memories with that person.
2. Do you have more, less, or the same amount of close friends as you had 10 years ago? Why do you think that is?
3. This week's message mentioned that crisis amplifies connectedness. Do you agree or disagree? Why?
4. Have you ever given someone permission to hold you accountable to something? What was that experience like?
5. Read the passage together. Why do you think Jesus sent the 72 out in pairs? What do you think Jesus meant when he said that he was sending them out like lambs among wolves?
6. In what ways do you think the world would be different if Christians were known as people who were open to accountability? Why is it hard to ask for accountability?
7. Finding an accountability partner is a three step process involving giving someone permission to hold you accountable, giving them questions to ask, and believing in second chances. Which of those three do you commit to working on this week?
