2 Corinthians 4:16-18

16 Do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. 17 For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. 18 So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.



Questions for Discussion

1. In what ways do you find your heart and lives “restless” and “wandering?”
2. Do you think some Christians treat God like a wireless charging pad—where you get “filled out” at church but then go out and do nothing outside of the church? Why or why not?
3. On Sunday, we looked at how Rembrandt and Kanye have used art and music to express how God reaches out to human beings. In what ways do you find yourself able to see God’s humanity? In what ways is it difficult?
4. Read 2 Cor. 4:16-18. How might you “fix your eyes” upon Jesus in the new year? Do you struggle with focus? (on God or otherwise!)
5. When we trade in our restless hearts, we must serve others because God first loved us. How might you serve the church and mission of God in the new year?
