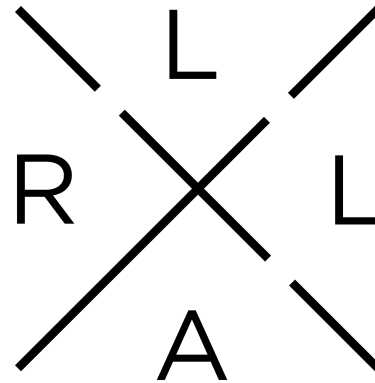
The Word Became Flesh

Questions for Discussion

1. Tell the group about a time that you were on a winning team. How did it feel? What do you remember about the experience?
2. Why does "dualism" - the belief that two equal and opposite powers are fighting for control of the world - attract people to believe in it?
3. In John's writing, he says that through Jesus all things were created. What's surprising about that teaching? What's comforting about that teaching?
4. What is one thing you can be more confident in this week if you believed more fully that Jesus had authority over that area?
5. What "next step" will you take this week toward trusting Jesus' authority? Who is someone who could keep you accountable toward taking that step?

As you close your time together, have each person share a word that represents a step that God is asking them to take this week and lift those words up to God during a time of prayer.
