Galatians 5:7-15

² You were running a good race. Who cut in on you to keep you from obeying the truth? 8 That kind of persuasion does not come from the one who calls you.⁹ "A little yeast works through the whole batch of dough."¹⁰ I am confident in the Lord that you will take no other view. The one who is throwing you into confusion, whoever that may be, will have to pay the penalty.¹¹ Brothers and sisters, if I am still preaching circumcision, why am I still being persecuted? In that case the offense of the cross has been abolished. ¹² As for those agitators, I wish they would go the whole way and emasculate themselves!

¹³ You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love. ¹⁴
For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.

- 3. Have you ever had God ask you to give us something that was sacred to you? What was that like and how did you grow in your faith during that season?

- 5. What "next step" will you take this week toward letting God speak into your life? Who is someone who could keep you accountable toward taking that step?

As you close your time together, have each person share a word that represents a step that God is asking them to take this week and lift those words up to God during a time of prayer.
