Ephesians 2:10-13

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

Questions for Discussion

- I. Have you ever experienced something supernatural? If you haven't personally, do you know someone who has?
- 2. Why do you think the church struggles to talk about and/or believe in the supernatural?
- 3.Read Acts 2:1-21 together. Isn't that a crazy story? 3000 people came to know Christ that day. Why do you think that happened?
- 4. If you want to experience the supernatural, you have to check your method of approach. How do you approach God?
- 5. If you want to experience the supernatural, you have to get dressed for the party. How can we prepare ourselves *now* for what God is going to do *later*. Read Ephesians 2:10-13. How do you put on the armor of God? Do you feel the presence of evil around you in the world? How is God going to overcome evil in the future?
- 6. If you want to experience the supernatural, you have to open your eyes. Read 2 Kings 6:15-17. God has our back. Where have you seen God at work in the world in supernatural ways?
